June Examination

The June examination timetables have been sent to parents and are also on the school's d6 communicator as well as on the school's website. Kindly ensure that your child is preparing adequately at home. These are our first major examinations and earnest studying and working through past years question papers must take centre stage. It follows that these examinations contribute hugely to the end of year results.

If Eid ul-Fitr falls on Wednesday 5th of June scheduled examinations will be written on Thursday 6th and if it falls on the 6th, examinations will be written on Wednesday 5th.

Learner Late Coming

Learners must report to school by 07:55 and report for registration in their form classes at 08:00. It has come to our attention that some learners are dropped off at school but loiter around local businesses and report late to school. They also place their safety at risk by not reporting punctually to school.

Learners who are late for registration without valid proof will be marked as absent for the day.

It must be noted that absenteeism affects progression at the end of the year. When a learner is absent from school a medical certificate or letter explaining the reasons for absence must be presented to the form teacher on the day the learner returns to school.

School Uniform

All learners MUST now be attired in full WINTER UNIFORM. It is also compulsory for all grade 8 – 11 learners to wear a blazer.

We also urge all learners and parents to plan accordingly for the winter school uniform. No learner will be allowed to wear jackets, beanies or any other garment that is not the school uniform. All garments that are not the school uniform will be confiscated.

We have introduced a new school winter rain jacket. The details are provided on the d6 communicator.

Detention System

The detention system has been re-introduced for transgression of level 1, 2 and 3 offences as per our school's code of conduct. The detention period will take place on a Thursday

from 15:05 – 16:05 in the music room and will be supervised by an educator. A task/s will be assigned to learners during this period.
